ATLANTA SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA LAUNCHES AROUND THE A SERIES PRESENTED BY PNC BANK WITH FIRST PERFORMANCE AT CENTENNIAL OLYMPIC PARK SEPT. 25 Free performances throughout metro-Atlanta from September 2019 through June 2020 to celebrate the ASO's 75th Anniversary Season

ATLANTA – In celebration of the Atlanta Symphony Orchestra's (ASO) 75th Anniversary Season, the Orchestra will hit the road for the *Around the A* series, presented by PNC Bank. All *Around the A* events will be free and will feature performances from ASO musicians in full orchestra or chamber ensembles, and from members of the Talent Development Program and the Atlanta Symphony Youth Orchestra.
