ATLANTA – Today, iconic actress/singer and Emmy and Tony Award-winning performer, Kristin Chenoweth announced a special performance alongside the Atlanta Symphony Orchestra (ASO) on Sunday, November 24, 2024. The television and Broadway star will perform fan favorites from throughout her remarkable career, dazzling the audience with her powerhouse vocals and captivating stage presence at Atlanta Symphony Hall. ## **About Kristen Chenoweth**

Emmy® and Tony® Award winning actress and singer Kristin Chenoweth's career spans film, television, voice-over and stage. In 2015, Chenoweth received a coveted star on The Hollywood Walk of Fame. In 2009, she received an Emmy Award for Best Supporting Actress in a Comedy Series for her role in "Pushing Daisies." In 1999, she won a Tony Award for "You're A Good Man, Charlie Brown" and she was nominated for her original role of Glinda the Good Witch in "Wicked" in 2004. Chenoweth has been nominated for two Emmy Awards and for a People's Choice Award for her role on "Glee." Chenoweth earned a Drama Desk Award, Outer Critics Circle Award and Broadway.com Audience Choice Award for her lead role in the Roundabout Theatre Company's "On the Twentieth Century." She also earned nominations for a Tony Award and a Drama League Award for the role.

Chenoweth has performed to sold-out audiences across the world, including performances at Carnegie Hall and Royal Albert Hall. Chenoweth released *The Art of Elegance*, her album of American Songbook classics via Concord Records. The album debuted at #1 on Billboard's Current Jazz and Traditional Jazz charts, and #1 on Amazon's Vocal Pop chart. Chenoweth also returned to the stage in her limited engagement "My Love Letter To Broadway," receiving rave reviews. In 2014, she released a CD and DVD of her own live concert performance, "Kristin Chenoweth: Coming Home." Chenoweth performed with The Tabernacle Choir and Orchestra in their annual Christmas concert. The concert aired on PBS and BYUty in December 2019.
