For Preliminary and Semi-Final Rounds: Candidates **must** Use Provided Timpani Candidates **may** use provided stool, **or** they can bring their own Candidates **must** bring their own mallets

For Final Round:

Candidates **may** use provided timpani, **or** they can bring their own (4 drums maximum) Candidates **may** use provided stool, **or** they can bring their own Candidates **must** bring their own mallets
