## **ST. VINCENT JOINS THE ASO FOR A SPECIAL PERFORMANCE THIS JUNE**

**ATLANTA** – Today, **St. Vincent** announced that her limited run of North American orchestral shows will expand, including a stop at **Atlanta Symphony Hall** this June. The Grammy® Award-winning artist will take the stage with the **Atlanta Symphony Orchestra (ASO)** for one night only on **Tuesday, June 23, 2026**. This one-of-a-kind performance will feature St. Vincent's greatest hits with orchestral accompaniment and will be conducted by **Jules Buckley**.

In addition to her newly announced tour expansion, on March 20, St. Vincent will release *Live in London!*, a digital album capturing last year's majestic BBC Proms performance at London's Royal Albert Hall. This album will feature the alternative rock classics reimagined by the 60-piece Jules Buckley Orchestra. Together, St. Vincent and Buckley will enlist established local orchestras to forge new sonic worlds from her acclaimed albums, including *Marry Me*, *Actor*, *Strange Mercy*, *St. Vincent*, *MASSEDUCTION*, *Daddy's Home* and *All Born Screaming* — in what promises to be a series of unforgettable evenings of unique symphonic reinterpretations of songs from one of modern music's most eclectic and acclaimed bodies of work.
