TWO NEW FILMS ADDED TO THE ASO MOVIES IN CONCERT LINEUP THIS SPRING

MATILDA IN CONCERT WITH DANNY DEVITO – MARCH 26 & 27, 2027

ATLANTA – Today, the **Atlanta Symphony Orchestra (ASO)** announces two new films joining the Movies in Concert series, presented by Invesco. The spring lineup includes ***Spider-Man: No Way Home in Concert*** on **February 11 & 13, 2027** and ***Matilda in Concert***, which will be narrated live by **Danny DeVito** on **March 26 & 27, 2027**. About *Spider-Man: No Way Home* in Concert

Spider-Man: No Way Home will have its acclaimed score performed live by the Atlanta Symphony Orchestra alongside the film, which will be shown on a giant HD screen, immersing audiences in every moment of the action-packed adventure.

The music for *Spider-Man: No Way Home* was composed by Academy Award® winner Michael Giacchino, who has composed the scores for all four of the Tom Holland Spider-Man films and helped define the character's musical identity on screen.

Released in 2021 by Sony Pictures, *Spider-Man: No Way Home* is the third Spider-Man film from Sony Pictures and Marvel Studios, earning over \$1.92 billion worldwide to become one of the most successful releases in Sony Pictures' history, and ranks among the highest-grossing films ever released. The film also earned widespread critical acclaim, including an Academy Award® nomination for Best Visual Effects, cementing its place as both a box office success and a fan-favourite.

In *Spider-Man: No Way Home*, for the first time in the cinematic history of Spider-Man, our friendly neighbourhood hero's identity is revealed, bringing his Super Hero responsibilities into conflict with his normal life and putting those he cares about most at risk. About *Matilda* in Concert with Danny DeVito

Based on Roald Dahl's award-winning book, this heartfelt film adaptation directed by Danny DeVito about a little girl with magical powers with awful parents (and an even worse teacher) has been an enduring favorite with audiences of all ages. Academy Award® nominated composer David Newman conducts his enchanting score live with a full symphony orchestra while the film is narrated live by Danny DeVito! If you miss this, you will be slightly less happy for the rest of your life!

The film was released in August 1996 by TriStar Pictures and earned raves from the more astute critics: "A sprightly fairy tale full of delight... effectively alternates warmth and sentiment with robust satire and knowing humor," said the *Chicago Tribune*. *Matilda* has enjoyed a cult following for two decades now, and the brilliance of the movie inspired other writers to create a Broadway version which has gone on to its own success.

For music, DeVito turned to his longtime collaborator, composer David Newman, who has scored all six of DeVito's features as director (including the popular comedies *Throw Momma From the Train* and *The War of the Roses*, and the acclaimed drama *Hoffa*). Newman says "Matilda holds a special place in my heart. The story of a little girl fighting to become herself, in a world determined to stop her, and to save the teacher she loves, Miss Honey, was so evocative that the music simply flowed. We recorded the score on and off for a few months, and it held a unique place for me the entire time — the collision between a child's point of view and the adult world working against her felt like a direct summons for music to be part of the telling."
